PRESENTERS AND TOPICS

Mark Wiesner – *Sharing Your Faith With A Believer of Islam!* The world that you grew up in is not the world that your children, or grandchildren, are living in. One of the fundamental differences: the tremendous growth and expansion of the Muslim faith in the world.

Ralph Geisler – *Reaching Rural Small Town Communities for Christ* As congregations witness to their small towns about Jesus Christ they become mission outposts in their communities. Mentoring activities designed to encourage individuals to witness through their hope in Christ will be shared.

Chad Lakies – *Using Social Media for Evangelism* Explore the implications of using social media (Facebook, Twitter, etc.) for evangelism. This relatively new medium which presents itself as a resource for the church requires some significant reflection before just jumping in.

Kevin Parviz – *Reaching Out...to Your Congregation?* How many members of your congregation do not attend church regularly? Is there a biblical model of fellowship for our churches that addresses this growing problem?

Jeff Gibbs – *Life-Affirming Congregations* People everywhere are facing “life issues:” chastity, infertility, unplanned pregnancies, abortion, treatment of disabled persons, end-of-life decisions. How can we enter these crises to love people and share Jesus? This workshop will encourage us to be Gospel-driven champions of life.

Andy Yount – *SMP: Formation, Reformation, and Kingdom Growth* This presentation will discuss the role of the SMP program concerning the formation of the next generation of pastors, the reformation of a non-evangelism mindset, and the blessing and mess of Kingdom Growth within a Lutheran congregational context.
