Dr. Buchholz studied organ and sacred music at the Berlin College of Church Music and the University of the Arts. He earned his Doctor of Music degree in orchestral conducting from Indiana University. As a conductor Dr. Buchholz has worked with many choirs, opera companies, and orchestras in the United States and Germany. As an educator he has been on the faculties of Cleveland State University, St. John Vianney Seminary, and the University of Denver. Dr. Buchholz is married to soprano, Dr. MeeAe Cecilia Nam.
