RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE WAMPNER-HOFFMYER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The funds awarded are considered a loan to the recipient and a loan agreement must be signed (see sample copy). However, after graduation and ordination, at the end of each year served as a pastor in the LC-MS, one third of the loan is forgiven so that at the end of three years, the loan is considered paid and the loan agreement is returned. A form 1099 (for tax purposes) will be sent at the end of each of the three years.

QUALIFICATIONS

- The applicant must have been a resident of the Indiana District of the LC-MS for three years prior to entering the Seminary.
- The applicant must be enrolling at the Saint Louis or Fort Wayne Seminary in a curriculum leading towards becoming ordained as a pastor in the M. Div. or Colloquy program.
- The scholarship is awarded on the basis of demonstrated financial need.
- An application must be filed annually.
- No funds will be given while on vicarage.
- Aid shall not be granted to a student for a second year in the same class.
- In granting aid, no special merit or demerit shall be given on the basis of the marital status of the student.

TIMETABLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

March-May	Obtain an application for W/H Scholarship Fund from the Office of Financial Aid Concordia Theological Seminary – Fort Wayne or the Office of Financial Aid Concordia Seminary – Saint Louis.
June 1	Application for W/H Scholarship must be completed and POSTMARKED BY THIS DATE to be considered for a scholarship. See address at the top of this page.
July 31	Recipients are notified by the W/H Scholarship Committee who will send them a loan agreement. Loan agreements are due back to the committee and must be POSTMARKED BY THIS DATE. See address at the top of this page.
Sept. 1 Dec 1 March 1	The treasurer of the W/H Scholarship Committee will send a checks to the Financial Aid Offices of each Seminary for each recipient of the Wampner-Hoffmyer Scholarship.

SAMPLE LOAN AGREEMENT

This loan agreement is between the Wampner-Hoffmyer Scholarship Fund (administered by the Scholarship Committee of St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church of Munster, Indiana) and _____. It is in the amount of _____. I agree this money will be paid by the Scholarship Committee to _____ Concordia Seminary as partial payment of my tuition. After ordination, as I, _____ complete each twelve (12) consecutive months of full-time work in the ministry, one-third of the loan will be forgiven, until after the third year, the loan is completely forgiven. If I would leave the Seminary for any reason, or fail to serve three consecutive years in the ministry, the principle and the interest (based on 2% below the prime rate at Bank One) will be determined and repayments would be made on a quarterly basis. I will keep the Scholarship Committee informed as to my mailing address.
