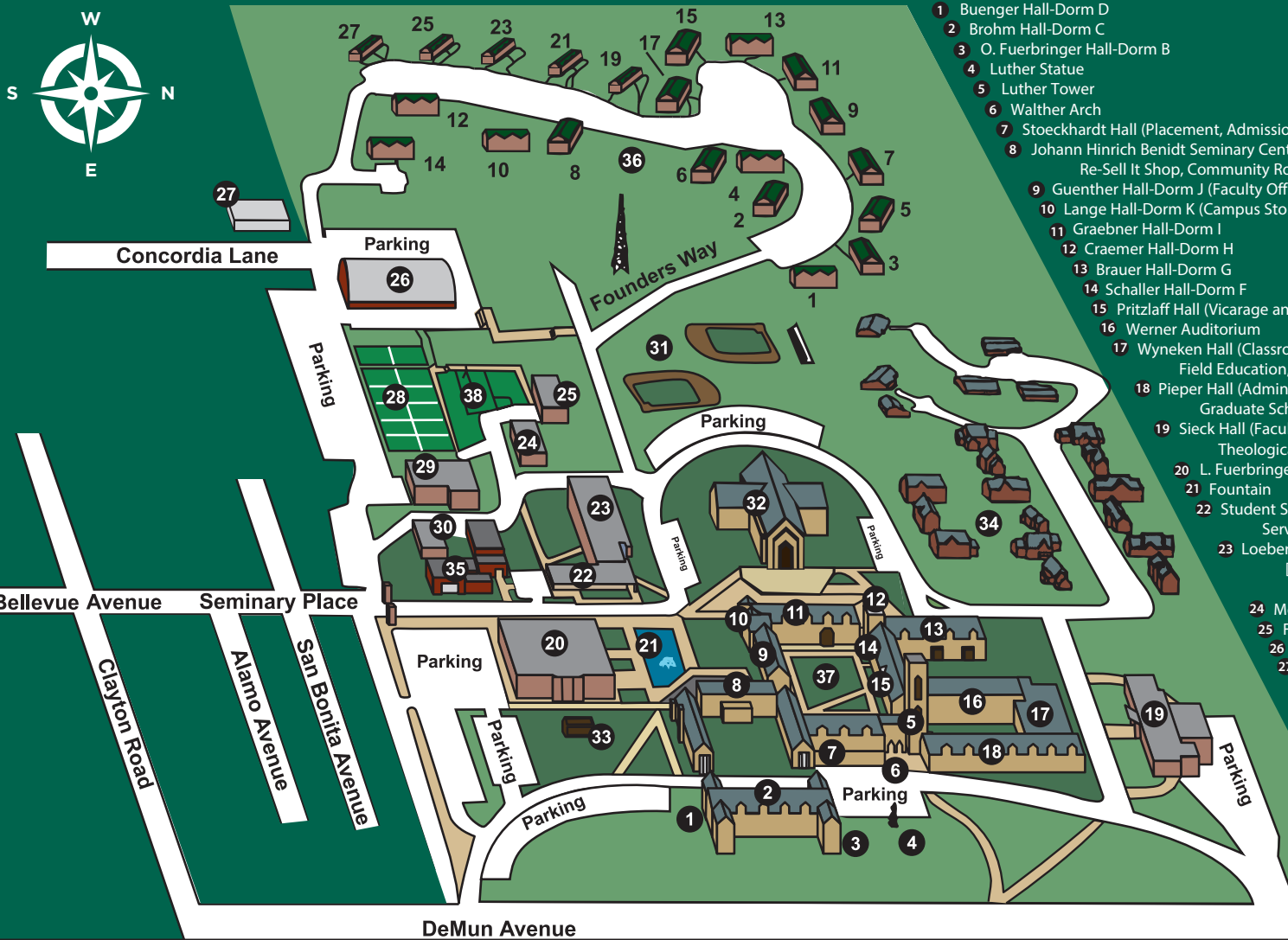


CONCORDIA SEMINARY, ST. LOUIS CAMPUS MAP

From East of the Mississippi River:

1. Go west across the Mississippi River on I-55, 70, 64 and U.S. Hwy. 40.
2. Continue on the bridge over the Mississippi River following signs for I-64/40.
3. Continue straight on I-64/40 for 6.1 miles.
4. Take Exit 34B to Clayton Road (look for the large Amoco sign). At the light continue straight (west) on Clayton Road.
5. Continue .5 miles to Seminary Place and turn right (north).
6. Continue north on Seminary Place for three blocks and enter the Seminary campus. The Welcome Center is 300 feet past the campus entrance on the right.

From the West and Northwest of the Mississippi River:

1. Take I-70 East past Lambert International Airport.
2. Just past the airport, take I-170 South.
3. Merge onto I-64 E/US-40 E via Exit 1A on the LEFT toward I-64 E/US-40 E/St. Louis.
4. Take the Bellevue Exit 33C.
5. Turn left on Bellevue and continue for .4 miles.
6. Bellevue turns into Seminary Place, continue three blocks to Seminary entrance.
7. The Welcome Center is 300 feet past the campus entrance on the right.

From the South (I-55):

1. Take I-55 North to I-44 West (exits left, after the Anheuser-Busch brewery).
2. Merge onto I-44 W via Exit 207B on the left.
3. Take Exit 286 Hampton Avenue to the right.
4. At the traffic light, turn right and continue on Hampton Avenue 1 mile to I-64/40.
5. Make a left onto ramp for I-64/40 West and continue .4 miles.
6. Take Exit 34B to Clayton Road (look for the large Amoco sign). At the light continue straight (west) on Clayton Road.
7. Follow steps 5 and 6 of directions "from East of the Mississippi River."

From the Southwest (I-44):

1. Take I-44 East take Exit 286 Hampton Avenue.
2. At the traffic light, turn left and continue on Hampton 1 mile to I-64/40.
3. Make a left onto ramp for I-64/40 West and continue .4 miles.
4. Take Exit 34B, Clayton Road (look for the large Amoco sign).
5. At the light continue straight .5 miles to the second traffic light, turn right (north) on Seminary Place.
6. Continue north on Seminary Place for three blocks and enter the Seminary campus. The Welcome Center is 300 feet past the campus entrance on the right.
