Support for Tuition

1 Residential Program Grant This grant represents 25 percent of the charged tuition and is guaranteed. During vicarage, this grant will fill any gap in tuition funding after all other support is received.



2 Reformation Jubilee Award Average of \$1,240 per student in residence. In celebration of the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, students in residence will be awarded an additional 5 percent of published tuition for the 2017-18 academic year, with the intention of bridging the difference, on average and in all forms, to fund 100 percent of the tuition charge.

3 Adopt-A-Student Grant Average of \$6,000 per student, per year. The Seminary is blessed to have many donors who commit to supporting a student through his academic career. In return for this financial support, students are required to communicate on a regular basis with these donors. Historically, students who have established positive relationships and have regular communication with these donors have seen an increase in their Adopt-A-Student awards.

4 Priority Endowment Scholarships Average of \$4,000 per student, per year. These grants are funded by donor gifts and investment income from endowments where the donor has requested the award be made to students who meet certain criteria, (LCMS district, geographic area, academic performance, etc.)

5 Incentive, Merit, Presidential and Regent Awards This category of financial aid rewards meritorious performance and addresses exceptional financial situations. Financial aid opportunities include:

Incoming/continuing students

- Eight grants ranging from \$1,000 to full tuition plus a \$4,500 cash stipend per academic year. *Deadline: Oct. 31.*

Incoming students

- \$500-\$2,000 for students graduating from a Concordia University System school or Valparaiso University. *Deadline: Oct. 31.*
- \$500 for passing the ELCEs. *Deadline: Feb. 28.*
- \$1,000 for the top 10 percent of GRE verbal scores (among all incoming Ministerial Formation students). *Deadline: Feb. 28.*
- \$500 for signing documents stating an intent to enroll. *Deadline: April 30.*
- \$500 for passing the languages. *Deadline: May 31.*
- \$500 for completing all required enrollment documents. *Deadline: June 30.*

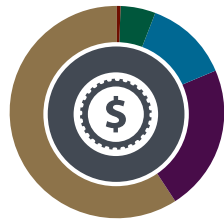
Continuing students

- GPA Scholarship - \$1,000 for students who maintain a 3.5 GPA after their first year of enrollment.

6 Partners in Ministry Average of \$4,300 per student, per year. The Seminary is blessed in its relationships with many LCMS entities that financially support our students in the formation for ministry. First among our partners in ministry are LCMS districts and the students' home congregations.

7 Scholarships Average of \$2,400 per student, per year. Many different scholarships are available to students attending Concordia Seminary. A listing of available scholarships can be found at www.csl.edu/admissions/financial/aid/scholarships/. The funding potential for scholarships is unlimited and can greatly reduce out-of-pocket educational expenses.
